Tuition: A reminder that the first tuition payment is due August 1st. A tuition discount of 5% is available to those who pay the full yearly tuition by the first day of school.

Payment Booklets for the 2018-2019 school year will be mailed if you have requested one. If you are planning to pay tuition on the monthly plan (August 1st – May 1st) and have requested a payment book yet did not receive one, please call the office. Remember only those who have paid the registration fee are considered registered.

Back to School Sunday: On Sunday, August 12th we are going to have “Back to School Sunday.” We are inviting each of the school children and their families to our 11:00 a.m. service. You’ll enjoy the friendly spirit, the majestic music, and a helpful message. At the end of the service each CBA student in attendance will receive a bag full of many school supplies for the 2018-2019 school year. Open House: Open House is on Monday, August 13th at 7:00 p.m. in the school gymnasium. This is an informational session for families who are enrolled and/or are interested in our school. We would like at least one parent from each family to attend. Students are certainly welcome. Classrooms will be open, and teachers will be available to chat.

First Day: The first day of school will be Wednesday, August 15th. As in the past, school begins at 7:30 a.m. and dismisses at 2:30 p.m. The buildings will be open at 7:00 a.m. The office will be open Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. during the school year.

Book Bags: Students in grades 2 – 8 should make sure that book bags fit into the lockers. If the bag can be compressed to fit into a locker opening that is 6 inches wide, it will be acceptable.

Bus Service: The following buses will service our school this year: Cincinnati Public, Mt. Healthy, Finneytown, and Winton Woods. For route or eligibility information, please call the transportation office in your school district.

Dress Code: Remember school uniforms MUST be purchased from one of the school’s approved uniform providers. We will continue to use Educational Outfitters as we have done for many years. Their address is 2656 E. Sharon Rd., Sharonville, OH 45241, and their phone number is 771-1234. You can find the link to our page of their website on the school’s website.

We are adding a secondary uniform provider this school year, French Toast. We will mail and email further information as soon as our webstore with them is up and running.

Health Requirements: If you have a child who will be attending kindergarten this year, we must have the health form filled out by your child's doctor, including dates of immunizations, by the time school begins. If you did not receive one of these forms, please call the office, and we will mail one to you.

All students entering the seventh grade are required by the state of Ohio to receive a dose of Tdap vaccine before they can begin classes in August. If you have a seventh grader, please send proof of vaccination from your doctor to our office. For further information or questions, please contact the Hamilton County Health Department at 513-946-7800.

All prescription and nonprescription (over-the-counter) medication, including Tylenol, Advil, ibuprofen, Roloids, etc., must have an Administration of Medication at School form completed by the doctor and the parents. This medication form can be picked up from the office, downloaded from our website, sent home at any time, or faxed to the doctor's office. Students may not keep medication in purses, book bags, lunch boxes, or lockers. Cough drops may be given with a note from the parent and kept in the office for storage.

Supply List: Lists for student school supplies were mailed out in June. Students will have through the first five school days to get all supplies. Each student should have the basic supplies (paper, pencil, or pen) on the first day of school. Supply lists can be obtained in the office or on the school's website.

Spring Test Results: The results for the spring Ohio state tests have been received in the office. If you would like a copy, please notify the office.
