**Tuition:** A reminder that the first tuition payment is due August 1<sup>st</sup>. Remember that only those who have paid the registration fee are considered registered.

**Back to School Sunday:** On Sunday, August 14<sup>th</sup>, the church will have “Back to School Sunday.” The church is inviting all CBA’s students and their families to the 11:00 service. You will enjoy the friendly spirit, great music and an uplifting message. At the end of the service, each CBA student in attendance will receive a bag full of many school supplies for the 2022-23 school year. Central Baptist Church and Academy thank you for entrusting us with the education of your child and this is one way to say thank you. We look forward to seeing you on August 14<sup>th</sup>!

**Open House:** Open House will be on Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the church sanctuary. This will be an informal meeting for families who are enrolled and/or are interested in our school. We would like at least one parent from each family to attend and of course, students are welcome. You will have an opportunity to meet the new staff members and talk with your child’s teacher.

**First Day:** The first day of school will be Wednesday, August 17<sup>th</sup>. As in years past, school begins at 7:30 am and dismisses at 2:30 pm. The building will be open at 7:00 am. The office will be open Monday through Friday, 7:00 – 3:00 during the school year.

**Book Bags:** Students in grades 2-8 should make sure that book bags fit into the lockers. The locker opening is 6 inches wide.

**Health Requirements:** If you have a child who will be attending kindergarten this year, we must have the health form filled out by your child’s doctor, including dates of immunizations, by the time school begins. If you did not receive one of these forms, please call the office and we will provide one.

All students entering the seventh grade are required by the state of Ohio to receive a Tdap vaccine and a meningitis vaccine before they can begin classes in August. If you have a seventh grader, please send proof of vaccination from your doctor to our office. For further information or questions, please contact the Hamilton County Health Department at 513.946.7800.

All prescription and over the counter medication, including Tylenol, Advil, Ibuprofen, Roloids, etc., must have an Administration of Medication at School form completed by the doctor and the parents. This medication form is available on line or in the office. When students need medication at school, the medication must stay

in the nurse's office. The students may not keep it with them. Cough drops may be given with a note from the parent but must be kept in the office for safekeeping.

**Supply Lists:** Supply lists are available on the website and were recently put on Class Dojo. Please make sure your student has supplies needed on the first day of school.

**\*Attention\* Some new things**

- All new students and all 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will need to purchase a Bible in the office at a cost of \$5.00.
- All students 2-8 will need to purchase an agenda from the office at a cost of \$5.00. All students 2-8 will be required to use an agenda this schoolyear. If the agenda is lost, they will be required to purchase another one. The student will be putting homework and conduct information in the agenda and it will provide another way for teachers and parents to communicate. We are asking that parents initial the agenda every evening so we can be assured that the child has shared important information.
- Students will serve a detention for every eight times they are tardy. Excused reasons for being tardy are a doctor's appointment, dentist appointment, etc. Unfortunately, sleeping late or getting caught by a train are not excused. This is important because EdChoice scholarships will be denied if your child is absent or tardy too many times.
